

How to Install and Use the X1 Wallet (Unpacked Extension)

Follow the steps below to install and set up the X1 Wallet using a browser extension.

PART 1 — How to Install the X1 Wallet

Installation Steps

1. Download and extract the wallet files locally on your computer.
Only use the official wallet files shared in the X1 Wallet Telegram:
t.me/x1_wallet
2. Open your browser and go to Manage Extensions:
 - Chrome: `chrome://extensions`
 - Edge: `edge://extensions`
3. Toggle Developer Mode ON (top-right corner).
4. Click “Load unpacked” and import the extension files from your computer by browsing to:
`Extension/extension`
5. Confirm the selection. The wallet extension should now appear in your extensions list.

Wallet Setup

1. Click the X1 Wallet extension icon in your browser.
2. Choose Create New Wallet or Import Existing Wallet.
3. Securely store your recovery phrase.
4. Complete the setup process.

Bug Reporting

If you encounter any issues or bugs, please report them using the official reporting link provided by the team.

Important Notes

- Only install wallet files shared through official channels.
- Never share your recovery phrase with anyone.

PART 2 — Access the Official XDEX

Join the official XDEX Telegram to get the correct links and verify the platform:
t.me/xdex_xyz. [XDEX | Swap](#) is the official decentralized exchange (DEX) for the X1 blockchain.

PART 3 — Bridging and Swapping Assets

1. Navigate to the Bridge section on XDEX.
2. Bridge USDC from Solana to X1.

3. After bridging, you will see USDC.X in your X1 Wallet.
4. Swap USDC.X → XNT, then XNT → other X1 tokens, including HOUND.
